## **'WHEN ICICLES HANG BY THE WALL'**

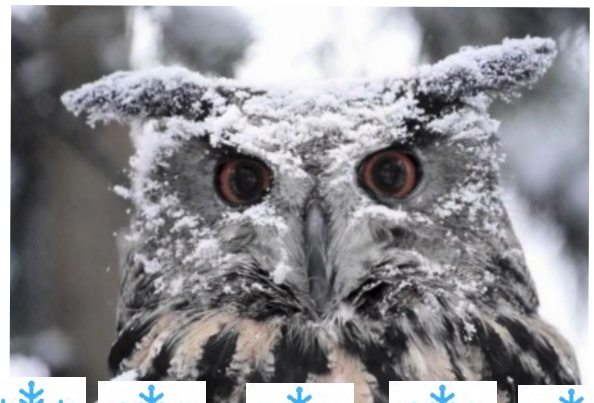
