## **COLLECT**

Risen Christ, you filled your disciples with boldness and fresh hope: strengthen us to proclaim your risen life and fill us with your peace, to the glory of God the Father.

## **GOSPEL READING**

### **JOHN 21:1-19**

Simon Peter and the disciples were by the Sea of Galilee. Simon Peter said, 'I'm going fishing,' and they all decided to go. They worked all night but didn't catch a single fish. Just after dawn, Jesus stood on the beach, but the disciples didn't know it was him. 'Cast your nets to the other side of the boat, and you will find some,' he said. They did so and then they couldn't haul in the net, it was too heavy with fish! John said to Simon Peter in delight, 'It is the Lord!' Simon Peter threw on his clothes and jumped straight into the water, while the others followed in the boat, dragging the net full of fish. On the beach they saw a charcoal fire, with fish cooking on it, and bread. Jesus said, 'Bring some of the fish you've just caught.' So Simon Peter hauled the net, containing 153 large fish, ashore. The net didn't even tear! Jesus beckoned to them: 'Come and have breakfast,' he said. None of the disciples dared ask him who he was, because they knew it was the Lord. Jesus came, and took the bread and gave it to them, then the fish. This was the third time the risen Jesus had appeared to the disciples. When they had finished eating, Jesus said to Simon Peter, 'Simon, do you love me more than the others?' 'Yes, Lord, you know that I love you.' 'Feed my lambs,' Jesus replied. Then Jesus asked him again, 'Simon, do you love me?' 'Yes, Lord, you know that I love you.' 'Tend my sheep,' said Jesus. A third time, Jesus asked him, 'Simon, do you love me?' Peter felt a bit hurt because Jesus had asked him three times. So he said, 'Lord, you know everything, you know that I love you.' 'Feed my sheep,' said Jesus. 'I tell you,' he continued, 'when you were young you went where you wanted to, but when you grow old, someone will take you where you don't want to go.' Jesus was hinting at Peter's death, which would glorify God. After this, Jesus said simply, 'Follow me.'
