Service Sheets

Over the Summer we went from having a comprehensive service sheet customised for each week to a service sheet for the season. We also stopped including hymns in our service sheets as we returned to using Hymn Books. We are trying to reduce the amount of paper used and printing. However, on a telephone or tablet this is not an issue.

Starting this week, we are providing separate service sheets for printing, which are divided into a Core sheet for the Season of Ordinary Time, and an Appendix with all the changable texts including the hymn numbers and scripture readings. Hopefully this will reduce printing to 3 pages each week, rather than the previous 7-10 pages. We will also provide a comprehensive sheet suitable for telephones or tablets.

This does not actually add to the burden for clergy, as I would usually prepare a comprehensive sheet for the purpose of presiding at the Service.
